CALL TO ORDER

The public hearing was called to order by Mayor Williams.

Public Hearing

Mayor Williams called for the opening of the public hearing for Notice of Violation of Hamilton's Ordinance Providing for the Abatement of Public Nuisances by Brandon Goss, owner of property at 306 W. Main Street, Hamilton, NC 27840. He publicly read the advertisement for the Public Hearing which was posted in The Enterprise, Williamston, NC and the High Country Press, Boone, NC. The purpose of the public hearing was to allow for community input regarding the violation as described in the Notice. Mayor Williams asked if anyone was present to speak.

An ordinance will have to be drafted for approval at another meeting. Attorney Lynn Coleman will be asked to draft the ordinance.

With no comments from the public, it was moved by Commissioner Taylor and seconded by Commissioner Freeman to approve the Notice of Violation of Hamilton's Ordinance Providing for the Abatement of Public Nuisances by Brandon Goss for property at 306 W. Main Street, Hamilton, NC 27840. The motion passed 4-0.
